




"I Am the Good Shepherd"

Although Jesus Christ came to bring "peace [and] good will toward men" (Luke 2:14), there was "a division among the people because of him" (John 7:43). People who witnessed the same events came to very different conclusions about who Jesus was. Some concluded, "He is a good man," while others said, "He deceiveth the people" (John 7:12). When He healed a blind man on the Sabbath, some insisted, "This man is not of God, because he keepeth not the sabbath day," while




others asked, "How can a man that is a sinner do such miracles?" (John 9:16). Yet despite all the confusion, those who searched for truth recognized the power in His words, for "never man spake like this man" (John 7:46). When the Jews asked Jesus to "tell us plainly" whether he was the Christ, He revealed a principle that can help us distinguish truth from error: "My sheep hear my voice," He said, "and I know them, and they follow me" (John 10:24, 27).
